

Special Emergency Meeting
March 2, 2014

A Special Emergency Meeting of the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wanaque was held on Sunday, March 2, 2014 at 6:30 P.M. in the Wanaque Municipal Building.

The Mayor called the meeting to order with the flag salute.

ROLL CALL:

On roll call, the following Council Members responded: Balunis, Cortellessa, Leonard and Pasquariello. Councilmen Pettet and Willse were absent. The Borough Attorney and Borough Engineer were also absent. The Mayor declared a quorum.

The Mayor read the following Sunshine Statement: Adequate notice of this meeting has been provided by the Mayor and Council by e-mailing notice of this meeting to the Suburban Trends and the Herald News newspapers on February 28, 2014 stating therein that this meeting would be held on Sunday, March 2, 2014 at the time of 6:30 P.M., in the Wanaque Municipal Building, 579 Ringwood Avenue, Wanaque, New Jersey, and a copy of this notice was posted on the bulletin board in the Wanaque Municipal Building on February 28, 2014, and a copy is on file in the office of the Municipal Clerk.

RESOLUTION #59-0-14 – Extending no parking on certain streets December 1st to March 1st

On entertainment of the Mayor, Councilmen Cortellessa and Pasquariello moved that,

WHEREAS, extreme weather conditions has resulted in a build-up of ice and snow along the roads of the Borough of Wanaque, and more accumulation is expected on March 3, 2014 and beyond; and

WHEREAS, the provisions of Chapter 108 of the Code of the Borough of Wanaque, sections 4 and 25, prohibit parking on streets of the Borough through March 1; and

WHEREAS, in order to safely clear the streets and roadways of the Borough, and to allow for emergency response through these narrow streets, it is necessary to extend the regulations to March 15, 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE BOROUGH OF WANAQUE, that in accordance with N.J.S.A. 39:4-197.3, that the provisions of Chapter 108, Sections 4 and 25 of the Borough Code, be and are hereby extended to March 15, 2014; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a certified copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Commissioner of the New Jersey Department of Transportation.

On roll call, all voted yes, and the Mayor declared the motion carried.

Councilman Cortellessa said how come it is only until March 15th.

The Borough Administrator said we can put it on the agenda for March 10th if we need to extend the date to the end of March.
