ORDINANCE #24-0-12

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCES THAT PROVIDE FOR AND DETERMINE THE RATE OF PAYMENT THEREOF FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF WANAQUE IN THE COUNTY OF PASSAIC WHO ARE NOT COVERED BY MUTUAL AGREEMENTS

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wanaque, County of Passaic and State of New Jersey as follows:
