2024 DOG & CAT PET LICENSE APPLICATION



STARTING JANUARY 3rd, dog and cat licenses for 2024 will be available through the Wanaque Borough Health Department. A form must be completed per dog and cat. Forms are also available on our website at www.wanaqueborough.com/animalcontrol.

License fees are \$16.00 for dogs and cats that are spayed or neutered or \$20.00 if they are not. For each **NEW** application, veterinarian's proof of spay or neutering & proof of rabies vaccination must accompany the application or the application will be sent back. For **RENEWALS**, only the proof of any updated rabies vaccination is required. **Licenses will not be issued unless the rabies vaccination expires after October 31, 2024.** This is a state requirement. If your animal is exempt from rabies vaccination, please provide us with a copy of a "Certificate of Exemption from Rabies Vaccination" form found on our Borough website at www.wanaqueborough.com/animalcontrol. If they are exempt from rabies vaccination, they still must be licensed.

Residents who do not license their dogs or cats by January 31, 2024 are subject to summons as provided by law and a late fee of \$5.00 per animal beginning February 1, 2024. **No Late Fee for New Pets.** If you no longer have your pet, please indicate that on the form or let us know by calling (973) 839-3000 x 7122 so that we can remove the pet from the system. If you have more than one pet, it's best to make a separate check for each so that it doesn't hold up the other pet's license should there be an issue with their rabies vaccination expiration date.

You can submit applications and payments one of three ways: Mail, Payment Drop Box (located in the Borough Hall parking lot) or in person at the Health Department office located at 579 Ringwood Ave., Wanaque, NJ 07465, Monday through Friday 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. *When mailing or using the drop box, list **ATTENTION: HEALTH DEPT.** on the outer envelope and provide a self-addressed, stamped envelope along with all applicable documents.
