Dear Wanaque Residents/Water Customers,

We, the Borough, are dealing with a large amount of calls and concerns regarding the air in our drinking water. Due to the severity of the water consumption, our Main Well is having trouble keeping up with the GPM's (Gallons Per Minute). During this time in the season, the demand for water greatly increases due to sprinklers for lawns, washing of vehicles, filling of swimming pools, and e.t.c. We greatly apologize for the inconvenience but please keep in mind that this is in **NO** way a concern that we might run out of water nor is any of this air hazardous for consumption. The Borough has extra pump stations that turn on when the storage levels in the tanks, drop too low. You can review our Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) on the Borough website, for a detail summary of what's in our water and what we test for. Thank you for your time.
