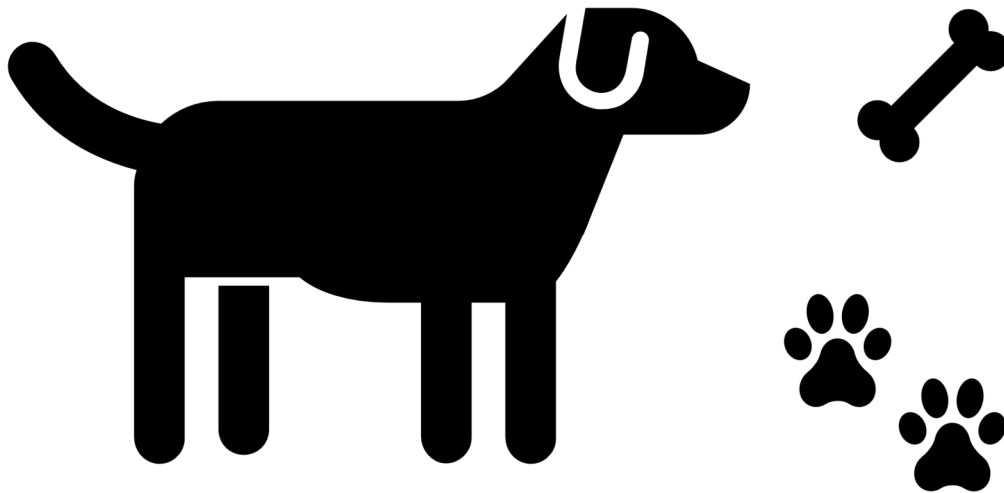

Wanaque Dog Park Information, Application & Regulations

Requirements: Completion of all 3 pages of the application form along with proof of rabies & distemper vaccination & proof of spaying/neutering. All documents must be presented with the application for processing. You must also certify that your homeowners/renter insurance has liability coverage. If any required documents expire during the year, it is your responsibility to provide updated documentation.

Tags: All dogs must wear a Wanaque Dog Park tag on their collar while in the Dog Park. There is a \$10 fee per household for the tag(s) (maximum 2 dogs per household).

How to Apply: Please bring the required documentation, application, and fee of \$10 to the Wanaque Health Office and your tag(s) will be provided. Alternately, send the completed application, required documents, and fee of \$10 via check along with a self-addressed stamped envelope to Wanaque Health Department, Attn: Dog Park, 579 Ringwood Ave, Wanaque, NJ 07465.

No dog will be allowed in the Wanaque Dog Park unless they have a Wanaque Dog Park tag & Wanaque Dog License tag visible on their collar.

It's the Law!

Animal waste from pets can pollute our waters. It is required that animal solid waste be immediately and properly disposed of in order to prevent high concentrations of nutrients, bacteria, and disease-causing micro-organisms from entering our rivers, lakes, and even drinking water.

When walking your pet or playing in the dog park please pick up the waste, wrapping and disposing of it in the trash or flushing it unwrapped down the toilet.

Wanaque Dog Park Waiver

Acceptance of RISK and Release of Liability: Acceptance of the terms and conditions of this release and adherence to dog park rules are conditions of membership approval, retention, and renewal. Membership may be revoked for noncompliance.

I hereby acknowledge that I have voluntarily applied to participate and use, with my dog(s), designated dog park areas operated by the Borough of Wanaque. I understand that unleashing my dog(s) and being physically present at a dog park area involves risk of injury to me, any individuals accompanying me, other people, my dog(s) including but not limited to, risks resulting from aggressive dogs, unpredictable behavior, and lack of training.

I further understand that despite the efforts of the Borough of Wanaque to ensure that owners have complied, there is a risk that not all dogs present in the dog park are licensed and vaccinated as required by law which could result in injury to a human or a dog. Additional risks include but are not limited to: dog fights; dog bites; theft or unlawful capture; escape over or under fences; vegetation or standing water that may be poisonous if consumed; burrs or seeds that may become lodged in the dog's coat, feet, eyes, ears, or nose; mosquitoes; ticks; chiggers; fleas and other insects; and wildlife typically found in a park such as snakes, raccoons, opossums, etc. It is my understanding that use of the dog park is self-directed and not directly supervised by an agent or employee of the Borough. I assume all risks associated with using the dog park, including fixtures and equipment, in an unsupervised and self-directed manner.

By signing this release, I agree to indemnify and serve harmless the Borough of Wanaque, its agents, officers, and employees and assigns from and against all loss, cost, damages, expense, and liability resulting from my use of the dog park, including death, sickness, injury, and disease to any person or dog or destruction to property, real or personal, arising directly from my use of the dog park.

I have carefully read this release of liability and understand, agree with, and accept its terms and conditions. I have also received a copy of the rules for dog park use and agree to abide by these rules.

Wanaque Dog Park Rules and Regulations

1. Dog owners are responsible and liable for the action and behavior of their dogs at all times and may use the park only at their own risk. The Borough of Wanaque will not provide supervision during Dog Park operating hours.
2. Dog owners must confirm that their homeowner's/renter's insurance has liability coverage before using the Dog Park.
3. All dogs must have current rabies and distemper vaccinations. It is recommended that dogs be on a flea or heartworm preventative medication.
4. No dog that is ill may be brought to the park.
5. All dogs must wear a valid Borough Dog License and a Wanaque Dog Park tag when in the park.
6. A limit of two dogs per adult may be brought to the park at one time.
7. Dogs must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older) at all times.
8. Dogs must be kept on a leash until inside the gated area.
9. No puppies younger than 6 months old are permitted in the park.
10. No children under age 8 shall be allowed inside the fenced area; all children between the ages of 8 and 18 are permitted inside the fenced area only if accompanied by an adult.
11. Owners are required to clean up after their dog and dispose of the waste properly. This is the law.
12. The owner must remove a dog from the park at the first sign of aggression. Continued display of aggression by any dog may result in loss of membership.
13. Female dogs must be spayed and male dogs neutered.
14. All dog bites shall immediately be reported to the Wanaque Health Department, 973-839-3000 X7122. If after business hours, reports should be filed with Bloomingdale Animal Control at 973-838-8959.
15. No food shall be allowed within the park (except water in plastic bottles). Play items must be removed when leaving. (Water Fountains are shut off during the winter so please plan accordingly.)
16. The park may be closed for maintenance without prior notice.
17. No smoking is allowed on the Dog Park property, including the parking lot.
18. Hours: The Wanaque Dog Park is open during daylight hours only.
19. Dog owners who fail to comply with the above rules and regulations shall be deemed in violation of Ordinance No. 10-0-2022.
20. Dog tags are not transferable.

I have read the Rules and Regulations of the Wanaque Dog Park and understand that violating any of these rules will result in my dog privileges being terminated.
