The state of New Jersey requires volunteer coaches to attend a "safety orientation and training skills program" in order to be eligible for civil immunity protection provided by the *Little League Law* (2A:62A-6 et. seq.) The curriculum for the Rutgers S.A.F.E.T.Y. Clinic is based upon the *Minimum Standards for Volunteer Coaches Safety Orientation and Training Skills Programs* (N.J.A.C. 5:52) and has been tested in court as having met the standards.

- Psychological Aspects of Coaching
- General Coaching Concepts
- Training and Condition Athletes
- Medical/First Aid Aspects of Coaching
