ORDINANCE #3-0-12

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF THE BOROUGH OF WANAQUE,
CHAPTER 110, TOWING AND STORAGE OF VEHICLES, TO ADD DEFINITIONS AND
AMEND FEES

BE IT ORDAINED AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Chapter 110-1, Definitions, of the Code of the Borough of Wanaque, "Towing and Storage of Vehicles" be amended as follows:

Add the following:

STORAGE DAY – shall mean any twenty-four hour period or portion thereof, with a new day beginning at midnight.

STORAGE RATES – Shall mean fees charged for the storage of motor vehicles

WAITING TIME – shall mean additional time that a tow operator spends at the scene other than the time required for the actual tow and/or recovery. This shall include but not be limited to the time during which Emergency Medical Services are being performed, or the time during which a police investigation is being performed.

WINCHING – shall mean the process of moving a motor vehicle, by the use of a cable, for a position that is not accessible for direct hookup by conventional means for loading on to a tow vehicle. Pulling a vehicle onto a tilt bed or carrier or lifting a motor vehicle with a conventional tow sling shall not be considered winching.

Section 2. That Chapter 110-14 (1) (A) be amended to read as follows:

- A. Towing services.
- (1) The following is the fee schedule for towing services:

Daytime Rate:

\$75 for regular truck

\$85 for Flatbed

Night Rate

\$85 for regular truck

\$95 for Flatbed

Waiting time - \$80 per hour, billable in 15 minute increments

Winching - \$120 per hour, billable in half hour increments (light duty)

Additional personnel – If necessary for towing or winching operation, \$80 per hour billable in half hour increments.

Section 3. That Chapter 110-14 (1) (E) be added to read as follows:

E. Emergency Roadway Cleanup when no towing occurs. If the debris from an accident is determined to be excessive and needs to be removed from the roadway. by a member of the Wanaque Police Department, the “on call” tow company may be dispatched to the scene. All fees will be billed by the tow company to the responsible party/insurance carrier. The fee for this service shall be 480.00 per hour, billable in half hour increments.

Section 4. Any ordinance inconsistent with this ordinance shall be repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistencies.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect upon final adoption and publication according to law.
