

NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Borough of Wanaque Passaic County, New Jersey

Notice is hereby given that the Borough of Wanaque, County of Passaic, New Jersey will receive sealed bids on November 3, 2011 at 11:00 AM prevailing time at the Municipal Office, 579 Ringwood Avenue, Wanaque, New Jersey 07465, and opened and read publicly for:

Façade Improvements to the buildings at 1066, 1068, 1072 and 1076 Ringwood Avenue, Haskell NJ

The work includes the furnishing of all labor, material and equipment necessary or required to complete all work set forth in these Specifications and shown on the Plans.

Bidders will be furnished with a copy of the Specifications, Plans and Proposal by the Borough Clerk, 579 Ringwood Avenue, Wanaque, NJ 07465. Copies may be obtained upon payment of \$50.00 payable to the Borough of Wanaque. There will be a \$10.00 postage and handling fee, if mailed.

Bids must be made on the Proposal form in the manner designated therein and must be enclosed in a sealed envelope bearing the name and address of the bidder and the name of the project on the outside, addressed to the Borough of Wanaque.

Each proposal shall be accompanied by a bid bond, cashiers check, or certified check payable to the Borough of Wanaque, in the amount of 10% of the bid, not to exceed \$20,000.

The signed Proposal forms and bid security must be delivered to the place and on or before the hour named above. The accepted bidder must sign the Contract within ten (10) days after the Notice of Award

Each bid proposal must be accompanied by a duly executed Non-Collusion Affidavit

The Borough Council of the Borough of Wanaque shall reserve the right to reject any or all bids if in the interest of the Borough it deems it advisable to do so, or to waive insubstantial irregularities in the bid proposal as permitted by law.

Bids may be held by the municipality for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and other bid documents prior to the award of the contract.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et. Seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27.

Bidders are required to submit with their bid a New Jersey Business Registration Certificate in accordance with N.J.S.A. 52:32-44. (P.L. 2004, c. 57).

Prevailing wages established under the Davis-Bacon Act will apply to this contract. Under NJ law, the contractor must use the higher of the State Prevailing wages or federal wages for each job classification. The contract documents contain requirements addressing prevailing wage rates, labor standards, non-discrimination in hiring practices, goals for minority and female participation, MBE and WBE participation, participation by Section 3 residents and businesses, and related matters.
