WHEREAS, Ordinance #15-0-16 ADOPTING A REDEVELOPMENT PLAN FOR THE PROPERTIES COMMONLY KNOWN AS BLOCK 200.20 LOTS 1 THROUGH 48 ON THE TAX MAP OF THE BOROUGH OF WANAQUE was adopted by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wanaque after second reading and public hearing on July 11, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance #16-0-16 APPROVING A TWELVE YEAR ANNUAL SERVICE CHARGE PROGRAM FOR THE RESIDENTIAL PROJECT AS PART OF THE LAKESIDE MANOR REDEVELOPMENT PLAN TO BE CONSTRUCTED IN THE BOROUGH OF WANAQUE BY GREENTREE REDEVELOPMENT LLC, A QUALIFIED URBAN RENEWAL ENTITY, OR A RELATED ENTITY was adopted by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wanaque after second reading and public hearing on July 11, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Bond Ordinance #17-0-16 PROVIDING FOR THE INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS IN AND BY THE BOROUGH OF WANAQUE, IN THE COUNTY OF PASSAIC, NEW JERSEY, AS PART OF THE WANAQUE-LAKESIDE MANOR REDEVELOPMENT PLAN APPROPRIATING \$1,850,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$1,850,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE BOROUGH FOR FINANCING SUCH APPROPRIATIONS was adopted by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wanaque after second reading and public hearing at a special meeting held on August 16, 2016; and

WHEREAS, Greentree Redevelopment LLC, named Redeveloper by the Borough in Ordinance #16-0-16 failed to take ownership of the property, Tax Block 200.20 Lots 1 through 48, referenced in Ordinance #15-0-16; and

WHEREAS, given the lack of a Qualified Urban Renewal Entity associated with the redevelopment on Block 200.20 Lots 1 through 48 the \$1,850,000 in funds authorized by Ordinance 17-0-16 are no longer needed; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wanaque have determined that it is in the best interest of the Borough to rescind Ordinance 17-0-16 and to direct the Borough's Chief Financial Officer to pay off the principal and accrued interest on the BAN issued on March 20, 2017.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wanaque that it hereby

AUTHORIZING A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE PASSAIC COUNTY OPEN SPACE, FARMLAND, AND HISTORIC PRESERVATION TRUST FUND FOR THE LAKESIDE PARK IMPROVEMENT PROJECT BY THE BOROUGH OF WANAQUE

WHEREAS, the Passaic County Board of Chosen Freeholders (hereafter “the Board”) provides grants to municipalities and qualified non-profit corporations for the assistance in acquisition, development, stewardship, and historic preservation from the Passaic County Open Space, Farmland, and Historic Preservation Trust Fund (hereafter “the Trust Fund); and

WHEREAS, the Borough of Wanaque desires to further the public interest by obtaining funding in the amount of \$60,000.00 from the Board for the county to fund the Lakeside Park Improvement Project at a cost of \$60,000.00; and

WHEREAS, the Board shall determine if the application is complete and in conformance with the scope and intent of the Trust Fund program and the rules and regulations established pursuant to R20170349, and any subsequent Resolutions passed by the Board governing the administration of the Trust Fund.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wanaque as follows:

1. Interim Borough Administrator John Eskilson is authorized to make application, provide all required information and documents as required and correspond as necessary for a grant to the Passaic County Open Space, Farmland, and Historic Preservation Trust Fund; and
2. That the Mayor of the Borough of Wanaque is hereby authorized to execute a grant agreement and any amendment as may be required with the County of Passaic for the Lakeside Park Improvement Project; and
3. That, if funds provided by the County of Passaic are less than the total project cost specified above, the applicant has the balance of funding necessary to complete the project; and
4. The Borough, as applicant, agrees to comply with all applicable federal, State, County and local laws, rules and regulations in its performance of the project; and
5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

Re: Cell Tower

On entertainment of the Mayor, Councilmen Pasquariello and Willse moved that,
WHEREAS, Subcarrier Communication is the owner of property known as Block 250, Lot 1 on the Borough Tax Map, being commonly known as 1 Skyline Drive, Wanaque, New Jersey; and

WHEREAS, Subcarrier Communication maintains an existing communications tower located on the said property; and

WHEREAS, the communication tower provides radio based communications system utilized by area emergency service providers; and

WHEREAS, the said communication tower is in emergent need of repair requiring a temporary tower to be constructed while the repair is effected to the said communications tower; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the residents of the Borough of Wanaque and surrounding communities that a permanent tower be repaired and that a temporary tower be constructed during such repair;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wanaque, County of Passaic and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. Subcarrier Communications is granted permission to construct an emergency communication tower on premises identified as Block 250, Lot 1, commonly known as 1 Skyline Drive, Wanaque, New Jersey.
2. The said emergency tower shall not exceed 125 feet in height upon which shall be located only those users presently on the permanent tower which is to be repaired which users were represented to be non-commercial, non-paying and non-profit organizations. The Borough of Wanaque shall be permitted to have access and use of the temporary tower. There shall be no wireless users on the temporary tower as it is represented that all present users do not pay fees or rent from subcarrier.
3. Subcarrier shall make application to the Board of Adjustment of the Borough of Wanaque within six (6) months for permission to erect a permanent tower. The decision of the Governing Body to allow the erection of a temporary tower shall not bind the said Board of Adjustment and is without prejudice to said Board of Adjustment's determination concerning the permanent tower.
4. If a permanent tower shall be granted permission by the Board of Adjustment to be erected in the future, the applicant shall remove the temporary tower upon completion of the permanent tower.
5. The Borough of Wanaque shall be accorded the right to have access to utilize the permanent tower and temporary tower without cost and shall have a Right of First Refusal as to location, on the permanent tower for any signaling, wireless, cell or other electronic transmission of signals without cost.
6. Subcarrier Communications shall comply with the Wanaque Borough Ordinances with respect to commercial cell tower location as well as any and all applicable County, State and Federal Laws and Regulations if its purpose is for commercial use.
