Dear Fellow Residents,

The oldest volunteer organization in town is the Wanaque Borough Fire Department, which dates back to 1910. The men and women of the Fire Department are on call 24/7 ready to respond to fires, car accidents and other calls for help from our residents. We have two fire companies – Company #1 located on Ringwood Avenue and Company #2 on Fourth Avenue in Haskell.

The Wanaque Borough Fire Department is continuing to respond to every call but is now limiting the number of firefighters on trucks. In cases where only one or two firefighters are needed to enter a home or business, the others responding firefighters remain outside. If there is a working fire, firefighters will respond directly to the scene. They are following all social distancing protocols as best they can, to protect both you and them.

The Fire Department is in need of volunteers. They also have a Junior program for 16 to 18 year old volunteers.
