**ORDINANCE #16-0-17**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCES THAT PROVIDE FOR AND DETERMINE THE RATE OF PAYMENT THEREOF FOR THE EMPLOYEES OF THE BOROUGH OF WANAQUE IN THE COUNTY OF PASSAIC WHO ARE BOTH COVERED AND NOT COVERED BY MUTUAL AGREEMENTS

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Wanaque, County of Passaic and State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. The rate of compensation effective January 1, 2018 shall be as herein set forth below, with the minimum salary being the hourly minimum wage as established by the State of New Jersey:


