April 16, 2014

This is the Regular Meeting of the Wanaque Board of Health held on Wednesday, April 16, 2014, in the Municipal Building, and called to order by President Frank Riccardelli at 7:30 p.m.

Member Bender inquired about recreational bathing Health Secretary replied this included the pools and spas in town at Brookside Heights, Wanaque Reserve, The Holiday Inn and Elks Camp Moore.

Member Van Rossen made a complaint about the coffee at the Quick Chek that she felt made her ill for three days. Chris Chapman said he will have Gina the health specialist look into it.

President Riccadelli commented on the nice reports Gina the Registered Environmental Health Specialist prepares.

### **HEALTH OFFICER'S REPORT**

Chris mentioned the two new establishments in town. Crisp's and the Ice Cream Social.

Flips is now doing Karaoke night.

Member Rich inquired about the new business application for Ziebrt. Was told they do under coating for cars and trucks to prevent them from rusting.

Chris said we are offering a food handling course for non-managerial food handlers. Member Bertelloni inquired if it is a requirement. Chris said there is a requirement for Serve Safe which is an 8 hour course for persons in charge (PICs) You have to have a person in charge at all times in retail food establishments where there is food handling and there could be a possibility of hazardous food. Not packaged food, restaurant handled food. The food handling course we are offering by the health educator and food inspectors is oriented towards people who would otherwise not get any education except from other workers in the restaurant. Member Bender asked how we are getting this out. Chris said by mailings to all the establishments.

President Ricardelli asked if there were any other comments or questions. No other comments or questions.
